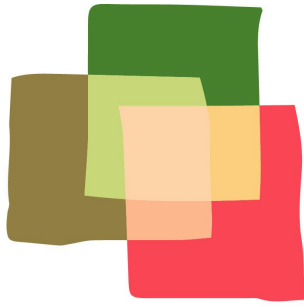




ART IN THE COUNTY

Entry Rules - Entry in the show constitutes acceptance of the following rules

Artworks must have been completed since the last edition of Art in the County, be original, unaided work except where work is a collaboration. All works must be for sale and remain on view for the duration of the show.

When a work is sold, a 35% commission is retained by Art in the County. The balance will be forwarded to the artist as soon as possible.

You must ensure that:

- Photographs and works on paper framed.
- Two-dimensional works must be no larger than 60" x 60" (frame included).
- Sculptures are of reasonable size. Artists submitting sculpture are responsible for moving it into and out of the gallery space.
- A maximum of two (2) pieces in any medium may be entered.
- All 2D works are ready to hang with wire and eye hooks only.

New in 2026: Artwork is insured by County Arts while on show premises (206 Main Street, Unit 2E, Picton ON K0K 2T0), up to a maximum of \$10,000 for an individual artwork and \$100,000 for the entire collection. Prince Edward County Arts Council assumes no responsibility for any works not picked up after July 13th..

Artwork in the gallery may be photographed by County Arts and published as part of AITC promotional material, including on the AITC website.

All selected artworks will also be available for public viewing through the Art in the County website. The Prince Edward County Arts Council is not responsible for any damages resulting from third party download of images that may occur.

Artwork Dropoff

***NEW THIS YEAR - Following the jurying process:**

Artwork will be juried online by a blind jury. Only artists accepted into the exhibition will be notified by email on June 18 to deliver their artwork to the County Arts Lab on **Friday, June 19, between 9:00 am and 4:00 pm.**

If you signed up for a critique and your work is not accepted into the exhibition, you will still be invited to bring your work to the County Arts Lab for an in-person critique on Sunday, June 21. You will be contacted with a confirmed critique time between 2:00 and 5:00 PM.

Artwork Pickup

Following the show's closure:

At the end of the show, buyers will be invited to pick up their purchased work on Sunday, July 12th. Artists whose work has not been sold are asked to pick up on **Monday, July 13th between 9:00 AM and 5:00 PM** at County Arts Lab 206 Main St. W, Unit 2E, Picton, where they will be grouped in alphabetical order to expedite the process.

Some buyers may be unable to pick up on July 12th. In these cases, artists are asked to pick up their artwork on July 13th and liaise with the buyer to arrange delivery. AITC will not pay the cost of shipping; this must be arranged between the buyer and the artist.
