Submitting a Photograph of your Artwork

Image size: Images should be a minimum of 2000 pixels along the longest side (or 2000 x 2000 pixels if the images are square) saved as a JPG. Files must be no larger than 10 MB. If you wish to crop or resize your image while maintaining aspect ratio and quality, we recommend using Preview.

Image colour: For those artists with the knowledge, please colour correct, balance and sharpen your own images; instructions are provided in the photographing artwork websites above.

Video for 3D work: An image of the artwork is required for the online store/gallery. Artists submitting sculpture may send a short video of their sculpture for the jurying process.

Labelling your image or video: The name of the file containing the image or video of the artwork should include your initials and the title as it appears on the registration form. For example: JS_Beautiful_Day.jpg.
